Weighting of votes:

In accordance with Article 16(5) of the Treaty on European Union and consequently of Article 3(3) of Protocol No 36 on Transitional Provisions, a **qualified majority** (in favour = positive opinion or against = negative opinion) is achieved with 255 votes (out of the total of 345), expressed by a majority of the Member States (at least 14 delegations). A delegation may request verification that the Member States constituting the qualified majority represent at least 62% of the total population of the Union. In the framework of Comitology a qualified majority is required under the examination procedure.
